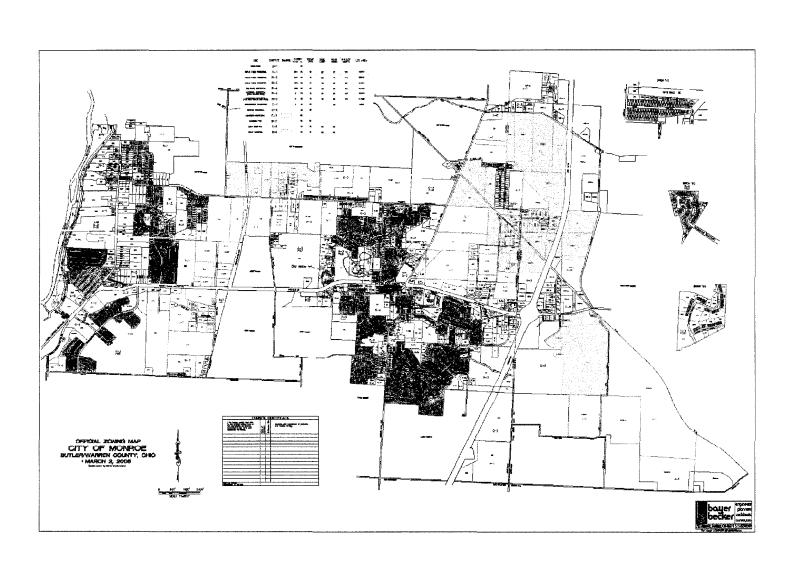

# LEGAL DESCRIPTION 23.120 ACRES PROPOSED HAMILTON COMPRESSOR SITE

Situated in Section 1, Town 2, Range 4, Turtlecreek Township, City of Monroe, Warren County, Ohio and being part of the 64.172 acre parcel conveyed to Berns Greenhouse & Garden Center, Inc. in O.R. 708 Page 624 and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of Section 1;

Thence along the north line of Section 1, S86°36'24"E a distance of 2685.45 feet;

Thence S01°35'36"W a distance of 911.26 feet to a railroad spike found in the centerline of Greentree Road, said point being the northwest corner of the above referenced 64.172 acre parcel:

Thence along the west line of said 64.172 acre parcel, S01°47'04"W a distance of 2082.94 feet to a 5/8" iron pin set at the True Point of Beginning;

Thence along a line through said parcel, S87°28'21"E, passing a 5/8" iron pin set in the westerly limited access right-of-way line of Interstate Route 75 at 813.45 feet, a total distance of 1012.16 feet to a point in the east line of said 64.172 acre parcel, being in the easterly half of I-75;

Thence along the easterly line of said 64.172 acre parcel, S02°21'43"W a distance of 1000.00 feet to the southeast corner of said 64.172 acre parcel;

Thence along the south line of said parcel, being in part along the north line of an 85.4858 acre parcel conveyed to Benedict Commercial Properties – IX, LLC in O.R. 3776 Page 289, N87°28'21"W, passing the westerly limited access right-of-way line of Interstate Route 75 at 197.99 feet and a ½" iron pin found at 228.67 feet, a total distance of 1002.08 feet to the southwest corner of said 64.172 acre parcel;

Thence along the west line of said parcel, being the east line of a 90.263 acre parcel conveyed to Jay and Helen Real Estate, LLC in O.R. 3807 Page 248, N01°47'04"E, passing a fence corner post found at 31.62 feet, a total distance of 1000.08 feet to the Point of Beginning, containing 23.120 acres more or less and being subject to easements, restrictions, and rights-of-way of record.

Beginning at a railroad spike found in the centerline of Greentree Road, said point being the northwest corner of the above referenced 64.172 acre parcel:

Thence along the centerline of Greentree Road and the north line of said parcel, S54°53'24"E a distance of 130.76 feet;

Thence leaving the centerline of Greentree Road and along lines through said 64.172 acre parcel, the following three courses:

- 1.) S22°35'12"W a distance of 124.82 feet;
- 2.) S22°07'53"W a distance of 100.47 feet;
- 3.) S01°47'04"W a distance of 1800.60 feet to a point in the north line of a proposed 23.120 acre parcel;

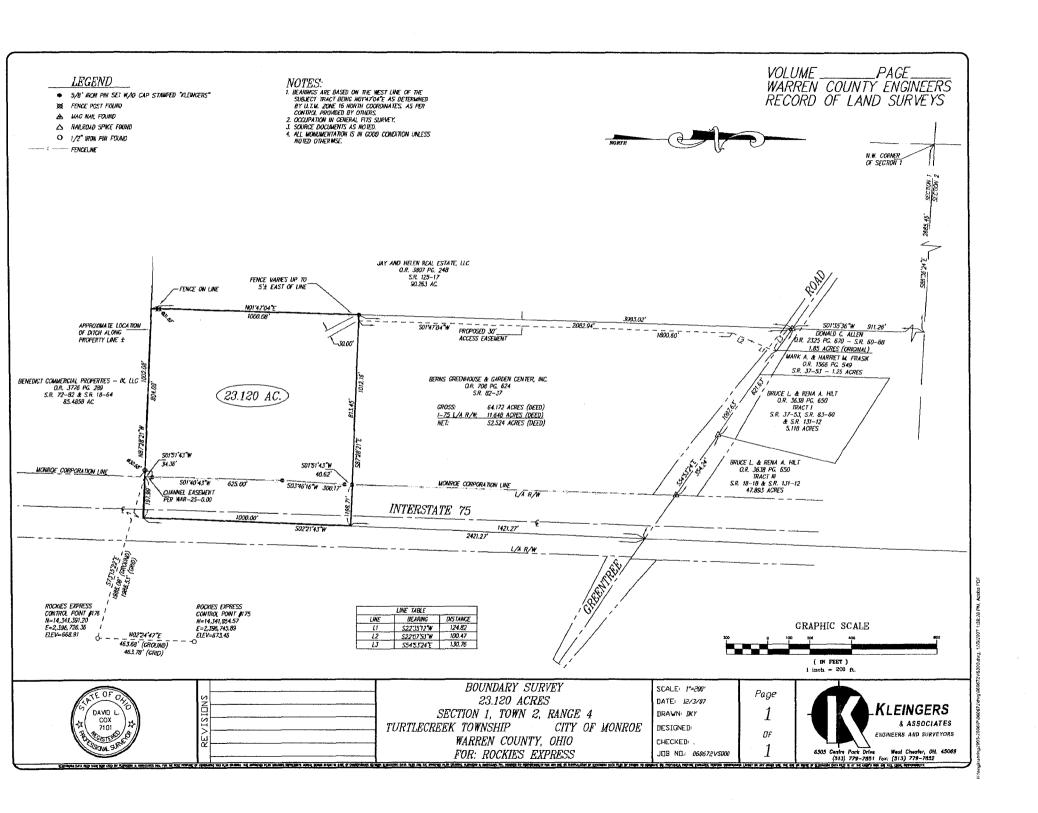

### Kinder Morgan Compressor Station Sign Plan – Guidelines

All Kinder Morgan compression stations will have signs installed that meet or exceed all federal, state, and local regulations.

#### Main Gate: (Attachment 1)

A station sign will be installed inside the station fence and located near the main gate. The sign will be approximately 72" wide x 48" high, and will include: name of company; compressor station name and/or number; county; state; and emergency contact information.

#### Perimeter Fence Signs: (Attachment 2)

All Kinder Morgan compressor stations are required to be fenced and signs posted as per Engineering Standard, Section 26 (Security). Specifically, Engineering Standard E0200 (Compression), Section 26.2.6. states:

Clearly visible "No Trespassing" signs shall be installed facing outward on each side at a minimum of 100-foot intervals on fences and gates along the entire facility perimeter. Wording for "No Trespassing" signs shall be as follows:

#### NO TRESPASSING

This property is patrolled and under 24-hour surveillance. Violators will be prosecuted under federal law.

On visitor gates, the following shall be included:

By entering this facility, all visitors consent to a search of their vehicles and property.

In addition to the signs listed above, the pipeline marker signs will be placed at all the compressor stations wherever a pipeline crosses the compressor station fence line, a line marker will be installed as per KM O&M Procedure 205 (Pipeline Markers and Cover).
